

Vote on more Businesses on Federal! After recent rezoning and remodeling of commercial space at 25th and Eliot, residents now have a chance to support a streetscape and pedestrian mobility project tied in with the 2017 Denver GO Bond. Improving pedestrian access to our business district will increase the sustainability of those businesses and encourage commercial improvements along Federal.

You can apply for a free permit in person at the Parking Cashier Office (201 W. Colfax Ave., Dept. 110, Denver, CO 80202) or online at www.

You will need to show utility bills, valid driver's license and vehicle registration to apply.
