Opportunity to give feedback on new development

Brian Ray, of Ray Design Development, plans to present a project he hopes to see a zoning change approved by Jefferson Park United Neighbors. Jefferson Heights is intended to be an 8 unit, 3 story small condo project that affronts Jefferson Park on W. 22nd Ave.

Ray says that his project would provide an attractive and sustainable option for new home buyers looking for an affordable residence in a welcoming neighborhood.

Some neighbors have expressed concerns that the project does not fall under current zoning codes and feel that the project is not in character with the surrounding developments. However, others feel the project is a good fit.

"It is my hope to design and develop quality projects in Jefferson Park and to build the confidence of the residents and neighborhood organization," Ray said in a letter to Jefferson Park residents. "I believe Jefferson Heights would be a great addition to Jefferson Park and as such invite you to attend the General Membership meeting to learn more of the project."

Ray will be presenting the project to garner feedback from the community though no vote will be taken.

Building features include:

Building materials similar to those found on existing nearby projects including Jefferson Park Townhomes, Zocalo, and Riverclay.

At only 3 stories, the views from newly constructed 4 story Jefferson Park Townhomes would be preserved.

Building is designed to have appearance of 3 small buildings in lieu of 1 larger building as a means to provide visual interest and creating view corridors.

- -Generous building separation created by the expanded alley to the East and the existing alley to the West.
- -Building height for the project will be restricted to a maximum of 34' to be respectful of adjacent residents.
- Current design is 3rd attempt with each revision reducing the size and height of the building to better conform with the existing neighborhood.

Jefferson Park community gardeners are thrilled to be providing squash for the culinary students at the CEC/Middle College. On Friday September 10th, calabacitas featuring uber-local papaya pear squash



will be part of the Mexican Fiesta Lunch Buffet for the Eliot Street Café Pre-Grand Opening. Jefferson Park neighbors are welcome!

With the help of Groundwork Denver, Denver Urban Gardens, Jefferson Park United Neighbors and students and staff at CEC/Middle College, the new garden got off the ground this summer, and is producing, tomatoes, jalapenos, bell peppers, tomatillos, radishes, herbs, pumpkins, corn, and lots of squash!

One of the goals of the new garden is to provide learning opportunities for the students at CEC. With the bounty of squash, Trish Wilson, the new Culinary Arts Instructor, can help her students follow food from the garden to the stove. Eliot Street Café is a student run restaurant serving both breakfast and lunch. From the back of the house to the front, students perform all of the café's duties, giving them a solid foundation for employment upon graduation. Students are creating all new menus this year, which will incorporate local, fresh and healthy foods.
