

ZONING REQUEST FOR UP TO 12 STORIES ACROSS FROM THE AQUARIUM

Steve Farris from the Real Estate Garage has asked JPUN's Land Use Committee to consider supporting the rezoning a cluster of properties at Water Street and 7th Street directly across from the Denver Aquarium.

The request for the new "D-CPV-T" zoning would support a developer building up to 12 stories in this area. The proposal also includes relocating the historic mansion once associated with the Zang Brewery and currently the home of Atlas Real Estate. The mansion would be moved approximately 250 feet from its current location that is highly visible from I-25 to between Confluence Kayak building and the west end of the aquarium parking on Water Street.



If the rezoning is successful, buildings up to 12 stories could be built on land currently zoned for up to 10 stories.

As recently as 2018, JPUN has worked closely with city planners to ensure the zoning plan for this area (the Denver Downtown Area Plan Amendment) promotes lower density along Water Street near the 23rd Ave Bridge and increased density farther north closer to Speer Blvd. The goal of this strategy



is to create a buffer from higher density being proposed for the River Mile redevelopment (Elitches) and the lower density that is more prevalent south of 23rd Avenue including the Children's Museum and the Element 47 apartment complex.

The request will be discussed at JPUN's Land Use Committee meeting on Thursday, September 1 at 6:30 p.m. Please contact us at info@jpun.org if you have any questions before the meeting. Otherwise please plan to attend if you have questions or concerns about this important part of our neighborhood. and wait a few days after a storm, so that the system can flush through anything that the storm washes into the river.


This information outlines the impact the event will have on access to streets surrounding businesses or homes on Saturday, September 10th.

The following streets will be closed from 8:30 am until approximately 9:30 am:

MILE HIGH STADIUM CIRCLE
WEST COLFAX AVENUE
WALNUT STREET
DECATUR ST BETWEEN MILE HIGH
STADIUM CIRCLE AND 21ST AVENUE
21ST AVENUE BETWEEN DECATUR STREET
AND CLAY STREET
23RD AVENUE BETWEEN DECATUR
STREET & CLAY STREET
CLAY STREET BETWEEN 23RD AVENUE
AND MILE HIGH STADIUM CIRCLE

While local access and detour routes will be provided, you may want to schedule Saturday morning trips outside of this time period to minimize any inconvenience. Please pay attention to signs, barricades, and traffic direction for your safety and the safety of participants. Even if there are no signs near your vehicles, TUCC would greatly appreciate if you would move your vehicle off these streets before Sunday morning.

16th Street Mall Renovation

Recently a sample installation for a new granite paver system and curbless configuration was showcased on the 16th Street Mall.

HOW THE 16TH STREET MALL PROJECT AIMS TO PRESERVE HISTORY

- A design that honors the original Navajo rug and diamondback rattlesnake pattern that has been a feature of the mall for 40 years
- A new granite paver system with better surface friction to prevent slipping
- A new curbless configuration that facilitates the movement of people across the mall and enables a variety of mall uses, including events and festivals.
- Approximately 40 feet of curb will be provided at each shuttle stop location, though it is not shown in the preview

The project is targeted to finish in 2024.



ARKINS PROMENADE IS DENVER'S NEWEST PARK!

Denver Parks and Recreation transformed Arkins Court, an industrial backroad along the South Platte River from 35th to 38th Avenues, into Arkins Promenade, a key part of a mile-long riverfront pedestrian corridor that will run between 29th and 38th Streets. The linear park includes amenities such as walking and bicycle access, river theater, gathering and play areas, an elevated walkway along the river, public art, and overlooks with seating areas. The promenade also provides outdoor spaces with

landscaping, shade trees, native grass areas, and planters to filter stormwater to improve the water quality in the South Platte River.



Robot Bartending at Bronco Games

Denver Broncos fans have a new option for adult beverages at the stadium this season. Stadium concessionaire Aramark has launched new high-tech cocktail bars at Empower Field at Mile High.

TendedBar — a 10-foot-long beverage dispenser — can hold 10 liquors and 18 mixers at a time. The bar features digital age verification. Aramark said Trueface facial recognition verifies guests' age for each purchase and allows them to mix up a cocktail with a few touches of a screen. Aramark said analytics also store guests' most frequent purchases to make the process even more convenient and seamless in the future.

Empower Field has the TendedBar at three stadium locations including section 110 on the lower

level, section 517 on the upper level and on the west club level. To enroll in TendedBar, stadium patrons will scan a QR code (below) and follow a two-minute process on their mobile device which includes adding their driver's license for age verification and payment method for cocktail purchases. Patrons won't have to pull out their ID when purchasing a drink
